Dear Dr. Samimi:

I am pleased to inform you that your video entitled **Outpatient Burch-Sling Procedure: A Nerve Sparing Method For Correction of Female Urinary Incontinence** has been reviewed by the ACOG Audiovisual Advisory Committee and accepted for inclusion in the Audiovisual Library. The reviewers felt that the program was well organized and represented a good teaching tool. The video will appear on the updated order form by July 1, in the mid year catalog, and ultimately in the 2003 Publications Catalog.

Currently, non-CME videos in the AVL are sold to members for \$55 and \$85 to nonmembers. ACOG will provide you an annual royalty of 7% for each film sold during the year. You can expect to receive a royalty check during the first quarter 2003 for the videos sold during the last half of 2002 and continuing until the video is withdrawn. All AVL materials are reviewed every three years to ensure their continuing relevancy to current practice.

In addition, any real or implied conflict of interest indicated on the above form will be disclosed during the introduction.
