First, Let me introduce myself. I am a Korean urologist working in the Seoul National University Hospital. Several months ago, I incidentally referred to your paper that appeared in the Journal of 'Prim. Care Update Ob Gyns' in 1998 (The outpatient Closed Burch-M.M. procedure for treatment of genuine stress urinary incontinence with no laparotomy or laparoscopy by newly invented bladder saver device). I have been very interested in the minimally invasive procedures for the correction of the stress urinary incontinence that could be done in my outpatient office.

Of course, TVT is a good alternative option in our country but I am not quite sure about the long-term effect of the synthetic TVT material. I cordially ask for your help to introduce your surgical methods and the device in detail. Also, I would like to know whether the device is available. I am looking forward to receiving your reply soon.
